**Campus Course Offerings:** Transition to High School and CASP BST at being held at the 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Center. All other courses are at the main campus.

**ATTENDANCE POLICY** Summer school instruction is very condensed and extremely intense; students are allowed only ONE (1) absence per summer school session. If a student misses a second day during any summer school session, he/she MUST make up ALL work missed AND PASS THE FINAL EXAM in order to earn credit. Failure to successfully achieve either/ of these requirements will result in failure to earn course credit. *EXTREME situations must be discussed with the summer school Principal (hospital stay, death in family, court appearance, etc.).* Additional absences will result in the student being withdrawn from summer school, unable to receive course credit. Tardies to school, to class, following breaks/lunch, and/or early departure are UNACCEPTABLE. Excessive violations in this area will result in forfeiture of course credit.

**LUNCH** Summer school is a closed campus. Students may purchase sandwiches, drinks, etc., from the cafeteria or bring their own lunch. Students **WILL NOT** be allowed to leave campus for lunch or break.

**STUDENT PARKING ALL VEHICLES MUST BE REGISTERED.** A summer school parking permit for the main campus may be acquired for a \$5.00 fee (valid for BOTH sessions); students with a current 2002/03 CHS parking permit will be allowed to RE-REGISTER their permit for the duration of summer school. *Unsafe driving* will result in loss of parking privileges for the remainder of the summer sessions. Main campus student parking will be in the lots located near the football field entering through the Randia Dr. gate.

## PARENT/GUARDIAN DROP OFF/PICK UP

Parents/Guardians dropping off and/or picking up students will be **REQUIRED** to use the **student drop-off loop** at CHS9 or **front entrance (off Oleander and Tucker)** on the Main Campus.
